Are you a nonprofit looking to for international compete development funding? Are you a for-profit social enterprise looking to participate in the international development industry? If you answered yes to either of these questions, this course is for you! Over three days, learn how to prepare your organization to be eligible and competitive winning grant money from the Agency for International Development (USAID).



COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Participants will learn the tools and programming language USAID uses and expects its applicants to understand.
- Participants will learn and practice using these tools and language to communicate their value to USAID or frequent recipients of USAID funding with whom there may be partnership opportunities.





TEACHING METHODOLOGY:

Using a recently published Request for Application (RFA), this course will break down the core proposal development tools applicants need to create a complete and competitive USAID grant funding proposal.

- This course is for NGOs with at least 3 years of progressive grants management experience.
- This course is also for social enterprises (for-profit organizations that sell products or provide services that help to solve social and/or environmental problems) with at least three years of progressively increasing revenue and market growth


